Happy New Year to you all, I hope your Christmas was full of fun and happiness. All the staff would like to say a big thank-you for all the lovely gifts you gave us for Christmas - we enjoyed each one.

This term we welcome Olivia to St. Peters Pre-school, we hope she enjoys her time with us.

Our topic for this term is 'Travel & Transport'. We have started the term thinking about train travel and how steam trains run. We've set up our own train station and ticket office asking the customers how they would like to travel on the trains... underground, above ground, long haul sleeping or maybe electric fast track!

We'll then move on to thinking about construction and how transport plays an important part of our infrastructure. We'll be looking at traffic signals that give us information, textures of building materials, road maps and taking tally charts of vehicles that pass preschool.

After half term break, we return to thinking about the RNLI; we'll create our own beach and have lots of rescuing while learning about water safety.

This will move us on to Air travel. We'll look at flight paths, helipads, space stations and of course set up St. Peters Airways! As we come to the end of the topic, we'll explore the world of travel & transport by hot air balloon using our world map for navigation.

I hope you enjoy hearing from the children about all the different ways we travel over the next few weeks and let's hope for a warm and dry approach to spring.
